CCToMM Student Delegates Awards

Mission:

The purpose of the CCToMM Student Delegates Awards (SDAs) is to provide financial assistance aimed at offsetting travel costs so that students may present their research work at the CCToMM Symposium.

Eligibility requirements:

To be eligible to receive a SDA, an applicant must:

- Be the first author on a paper to be presented at the CCToMM Symposium.
- Be a student member of the CCToMM in good standing at the time of application.
- Have paid registration fees to attend the CCToMM Symposium.
- Be a registered student at a post-secondary institution whose distance from the CCToMM Symposium location is greater than 100 km.

Value of award:

The value of the award is \$300.

Distribution of awards:

- SDA recipients are determined by a random draw with all eligible applicants being given equal probability of receiving an award (regardless of travel distance).
- SDAs are allocated until (i) there are no more eligible applicants or (ii) the value of the yearly budget allocated to the SDA program has been reached.
- Distribution of SDA funds is made at the CCToMM Symposium. Award recipients must be in attendance at the CCToMM Symposium to receive their award.
